Regathering Sunday – Quick Points

Quick Overview of Parkway Place's Regathering Plan

Parkway Place's Regathering Plan will be implemented in the following four phases:

- Phase 1 Online Phase (March 15 May 31)
 Worship online at home with family through our YouTube live stream. Small groups will meet online via Zoom.
- Phase 2 Regather On-Campus Worship Phase (June 7 late June to mid-July)* Regather on-campus with limited seating. Small groups will continue to meet online via Zoom. This phase corresponds to Governor Hutchinson's <u>Phase 1 COVID-19 Guidance for Places of</u> <u>Worship</u>.

The Regathering Team understands there will be members with deep convictions about regathering. You may have never wanted the church to temporarily suspend on-campus worship and you are ready to come back, yesterday! Others will need more time. There is grace in this spectrum. Parkway Place has a mission to make fully devoted followers of Christ. We are one church, on-campus or on-line. Come back on-campus when you feel comfortable. We will continue to live stream the same service! It remains the prayer of the Regathering Team for unity.

- Phase 3 Worship Transition Phase (Mid/late July late July or mid-August)* Continue to regather on-campus with gradual seating expanded. Small groups will slowly resume meeting back on-campus over the course of Phase 3 and 4. This phase will correspond to Governor Hutchinson's yet to be released Phase 2 COVID-19 Guidance for Places of Worship.
- Phase 4 Resume PPBC Worship Phase (Mid/late August Onward)* Normal Parkway Place worship and activities to resume. This phase will correspond to Governor Hutchinson's yet to be released Phase 3 COVID-19 Guidance for Places of Worship.
- * Future dates are highly subject to change

What can you expect on Regather Sunday?

- As you arrive, **expect to be greeted with air hugs and waves!** You'll park in every other lane and we'll use every other pew in the sanctuary.
- During our Regathering Phase 2, there will be limited seating and we'll have Sunday worship only. Small groups will continue to meet via Zoom. Because we'll have limited seating, members will be asked to RSVP a seat, which will help with our planning. An RSVP link will be sent to you.
- We will all use only one entrance and exit (the doorway that leads directly into the sanctuary). There will be social distancing signs and decals to help everyone visualize proper spacing.

Overall, we are asking everyone to *quickly transition* from the parking lot to a pew and back to the parking lot at the conclusion of the worship service.

- Based on Governor Hutchinson's Phase 1 Guidelines for Places of Worship, we have asked every member to sacrifice a little comfort for a season and out of love for others, to wear a face mask. If you forget one, no problem, the church will have a limited supply (about 200).
- The sanctuary will be sanitized before your arrival and there will be plenty of hand sanitizer stations available. The restrooms in the foyer will be available for limited (two at time) use.
- The most important expectation? Expect to worship! Despite any potential discomfort or distractions, we all have the privilege of coming together, either on-campus or on-line to worship our mighty God!
